

Hospitality Management Certificate with Co-op



Co-op



Admission Requirements

- 1. Students must be 19 years of age or over on the first day of class
- 2. Minimum High School Graduate or equivalent

If a student is from a non-English speaking country, the student need to meet one of the following

- 1. TOEFL iBT a minimum score of 60; IELTS academic a minimum score of 4.5
- 2. Successful completion of Grade 12 from a Canadian High School or equivalent
- 3. A score of 60% on the Create Career College English Placement Test

Students may enroll in ESL courses before starting the academic program

Managing Front Office Operations

The course covers the structure, nature and operating characteristics of the different sectors of the hospitality industry, as well as the interaction of management with departments like marketing, finance and human resources.

Introduction to the Hospitality Industry

This course details the flow of business through a hotel, starting from taking reservations to check-out and account settlement. The course also examines various elements of conducting effective front office management paying particular attention to the planning and evaluation of front office operations and to human resources management.

Managing Housekeeping Operations


This course provides a thorough overview of housekeeping—from the big picture of planning and organization and the hiring and retention of staff to the technical details of cleaning each area of the hotel. Also featured are industry experts who will present real-life examples and practical information.

Management of Food & Beverage Operations

This course shows how every aspect of a food service operation contributes to a guest's experience. The course includes an updated menu trend, responsible alcohol service, and material on leadership, service skills, and service styles.










